



SECTION: STANDARD PEDESTRIAN PATH

NOTES

1. PREFERENCE FOR GRADES LESS THAN 1:10, BUT GRADIENTS UP TO 1:7 ACCEPTED, BEYOND WHICH STEPS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED.
2. PATHS WITHIN PARKS & RESERVES WHERE REQUIRED SHOULD BE OF CONCRETE OR ASPHALT CONSTRUCTION & COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCESSIBILITY OF VEHICLES & EQUIPMENT THAT MAY TRAVERSE THE SURFACES.
3. PATHS WITHIN PLAYGROUNDS SHALL COMPLY WITH PLAYGROUND & DDA DESIGN STANDARDS.
4. ASPHALT IS PREFERRED OVER CRUSHED ROCK ON STEEPER GRADES OR WET AREAS.
