- GRADIENTS SHOULD PREFERABLY BE 1:20, 1:14
 COULD BE ACCEPTED IN SOME CASES. 1:10
 GRADIENT WOULD REQUIRE COUNCIL APPROVAL.
- 2 PATHS WITHIN PARKS & RESERVES WHERE REQUIRED SHOULD BE OF CONCRETE OR ASPHALT CONSTRUCTION & COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCESSIBILITY OF VEHICLES & EQUIPMENT THAT MAY TRAVERSE THE SURFACES.
- 3 PATHS WITHIN PLAYGROUNDS SHALL COMPLY WITH PLAYGROUND & DDA DESIGN STANDARDS.
- 4 FINE CRUSH ROCK (FCR)TOPPINGS SHALL BE UTILISED IN CAR PARKING AREAS.
- GEO FABRIC SHALL BE UTIISED IN AREAS OF WET CONDITIONS.
- 6 PATH WIDTHS SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE ACCESS REQUIRED IN THE PARK SUCH AS PEDESTRIAN OR SHARED USED OR VEHICLES
- 7 CROWN PROFILE SHALL BE USED ON SITE THAT ARE FLAT TO ENSURE POSITIVE DRAINAGE.
